



2018-2019 Supplies List (7th-12th Grade)

IMPORTANT NOTE: Parent Orientation is Thursday, August 30th, 7:00 p.m. - 8:15 p.m.

Supplies

Classroom Supplies (please send these with your student to homeroom on the first day of school):

- *4 boxes of Kleenex
- *1 large container Clorox Wipes – or any brand of disinfectant
- *1 large bottle hand sanitizer (please no soap, just sanitizer)

Individual Supplies:

- *Chromebook (*Previously purchased devices are acceptable.*)
- *Chromebook Sleeve (*This item is suggested for additional protection of your student's device.*)
- *Backpack
- *Three-ring binder (1 inch)
- *100 sheets of college ruled white, loose-leaf notebook paper
No spiral bound or perforated spiral bound notebooks. No colored paper.
- *2 standard blue or black ballpoint pens (*no gel pens or colored ink pens*)
- *2 red ballpoint pens
- *Six (6) #2 pencils
- *1 Set Colored Pencils
- *Combination lock for locker
Every student will be required to submit their combination to their homeroom teacher on the first day of school. Students will not be issued a locker without a combination lock.
- *Water Bottle with a Snap Close Lid
Students are allowed to drink water in class only if they have a water bottle with a snap close lid. Please write the student's name with permanent marker on the water bottle.
- *White Out tape (*Liquid White Out is not permitted on the campus.*)
- *Paper Covers for each textbook (no sticky covers, no stretch covers – paper bags are recommended to save costs)

Math/Physics Students

*The following items are required for **all** Math students*

- *Compass for constructions (must be good quality – purchased for \$3-\$5)
- *Protractor
- *Ruler with standard and metric
- *Graph paper (quadrille ruled)
- *Spiral notebook designated for math notes
- *Calculator (phones may not be used as calculators)

Algebra I, Algebra II, Geometry, Adv. Math, Calculus and Physics Students: In addition to the student's Chromebook, each student must have a mathematics/scientific calculator in order to complete testing. The calculator should be able to perform inverse operations. Cell phones may not be used as calculators.

All 7th-12th-Grade Science Students

*All 7th-12th grade science students must purchase a pair of splash/impact goggles to be worn during all labs. (Students will not be allowed to participate in labs without their goggles.) These goggles can be purchased at Home Depot for approximately \$7.00.

*One Composition Notebook

Chemistry Students

*Calculator (*Phones may not be used as calculators.*)

Art Students

*5"X7" (or larger) Sketchbook

*1 Set Colored Pencils

*1 9'x12" (or larger) Watercolor paper tablet

Music Students

*E tuning fork (can be purchased at any music store)

*50 sheets of staff paper

*Small portable keyboard (or other instrument of choice) – Piano is the preferred instrument if the student is not already enrolled in private lessons with a different instrument.

P.E. Students

*All P.E. students must purchase a uniform for class. *Students who do not "dress down" will receive a deduction in their P.E. grade.* Uniforms will be available at Parents' Orientation. The cost of the t-shirt will be \$25. The cost of the NBA length shorts will be \$30.00. If a student chooses to purchase sweatpants, they will cost \$35.00 per pair. Please write your student's name on all P.E. clothing after purchase.

All 7th-12th-Grade Students: Students in 7th-12th grade may drink water in their classroom – and on warm days this is important. However, they may only have water in **plastic water bottles with the snap close top. Each student should bring a water bottle with his/her name written on it with permanent marker.** Because FCS no longer has drinking fountains, but rather water stations to insure sanitation, it is vital that students bring their water bottle each day – otherwise, students will be sent to the office to purchase a water bottle.

REMINDER: In order for your student's chromebook to have the protections and safeguards of the school's system, the device must be managed by the school. If you have purchased a device, but did not submit it to the office for management, the safeguards do not apply to your student's computer. For more information, email office@fcs-online.org.
